

## HWPOA Board Meeting Minutes

May 4th, 2010

The meeting began at 7:10pm. Bob Dalton, Renata Davis, Karen Jones, Patti Dieterle and Allie Wisnom attended.

Bob Dalton announced that he had contacted the State Highway Administration and Rutland Road will be closed indefinitely due to a lawsuit regarding its repair. He also noted that the poor road work on Rte. 450 at the bridge over the South River headwaters will be repaired again soon.

The Yard Sale took place on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Approximately 5 families participated. Allie Wisnom will send a blast email to remind people about the upcoming county dumpster service.

The county workers have come by to scoop up the loose asphalt from the snowstorm damage. They will return to patch driveways.

Nancy and Herb Conklin requested a drawing of replacement signage for the front entrance. Bob Dalton presented the drawings for comment, since Nancy was absent. Board members commented that they did not like the script for the proposed sign and thought the proposed materials were inferior to the quality of our current signage (painted metal vs. bronze). Some members also wondered about the purpose of replacing the signage would be and if the cost was appropriate. It was suggested that the current wall may need repaired and that should take precedence over replacing signage.

Bob Dalton noted recent incidents of vandalism in the neighborhood – a street sign torn down, a puncture in the gazebo roof, spray painting on the Verizon box. Board members pointed out the likely offenders and the Board may choose to send a letter to their parents for resolution.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:50.
